

VP - Development >

Membership

The Membership Committee shall be responsible for recruiting and registering Booster Club members.

Grants & Corporate Giving

The Grants & Corporate Giving Committee shall be responsible for fundraising via donors—i.e., grants, sponsorships, etc.

Alumni Association

The Alumni Association Committee shall be responsible for engaging alumni to maintain ties within the Rebel Regiment family and also to make alumni aware of support opportunities—i.e., donations, volunteer needs, etc.

VP - Ways & Means >

Fundraising

The Fundraising Committee shall be responsible for fundraising via special events including sales, raffles, car washes, etc.

Spirit Gear

The Spirit Gear Committee shall coordinate the design and sale of band, guard, and booster merchandise.

New merchandise items will be presented to the Director of Bands/Guards and Executive Board for approval before sale.

Inventory orders must be approved by the Treasurer.

Bingo

The Bingo Committee shall coordinate the Bingo fundraiser.

VP - Operations-Internal >

Chaperone

The Chaperone Committee shall train and coordinate parent chaperones, as required.

- Work with District personnel to collect applications and submit for background checks.
- Develop an "approved chaperone" list.
- Conduct chaperone training to insure understanding of District/Band rules, expectations, and emergency procedures.
- When requested by the Director of Bands/Guards, plan and coordinate approved volunteers to act as chaperones on band/guard trips.
- Work with band/guard staff to manage disciplinary situations.

Food

The Food Committee shall coordinate food and drink for activities/trips. This includes planning, procurement, delivery, and serving.

Travel

The Travel Committee shall work with staff to plan and coordinate trips.

VP - Operations-External >

Middle School Liaison

The Middle School Liaison Committee shall support Band staff in coordinating recruitment activities.

Volunteer Coordinator

The Volunteer Coordinator Committee shall support other committees in coordinating volunteer recruitment.

This committee will be a central point of contact and shall use available tools--i.e., email, phone, text, social media, electronic sign-up lists, etc. to recruit volunteers.

Committees requesting volunteer services must define their needs--i.e., numbers, dates/times, etc.--and provide descriptions of volunteer roles.

Meet the Rebel Regiment

The Meet the Rebel Regiment Committee shall plan and coordinate supporting activities for the Meet the Rebel Regiment event. This includes concessions, sales, membership drives, special activities, etc.

Competitions

The Competitions Committee, with leadership from the Vice President of Operation-External, shall help coordinate planning for all competitions hosted by the Booster Club.

VP - Communications >

Public Relations

The Public Relations Committee shall be responsible for external communication and advertising via print, electronic, news, and social media. External parties include local media, school district, administration, and other interested parties.

Newsletter

The Newsletter Committee communicates internal information and announcements to the Booster Club members, students, and parents.

Web

The Web Committee shall be responsible for website design and update for main and competition sites.

Media

The Media Committee shall capture still photography and video throughout the season for use in websites, social media sites, presentations, advertising media, etc.

Technology

The Technology Committee shall setup, maintain, and train users of Charms and web sites. The committee shall also support activities and competitions, as required.

VP - Equipment >

Transportation

The Transportation Committee shall manage and maintain Booster Club owned vehicles. The committee shall recruit and coordinate training of drivers.

Pit Crew

The Pit Crew shall support mobilization--loading, transportation, unloading, and setup--of pit instruments, props, etc. for all performances, as required. Training and practice with students shall be required to insure clear direction and performance.

Props

The Props Committee shall work with staff to build, store, and transport props.

Uniforms/Inventory

The Uniforms / Inventory Committee shall help manage fitting, distribution/collection, transport, cleaning, and repair of uniforms and instruments.
