Title:	<u>Marching Band 1 (First Semester)</u>		
Unit Credit	1	Grade Levels	9-12
Prerequisite	Band teacher recommendation		

This course is designed for brass and woodwind students who are interested in being a member of the Rebel Regiment Marching Band. Participation in this course will require some after school practices and performances. The Rebel Regiment has won eleven state championships and is the defending 2017 Upper State Champions.

This course is designed for percussion students who are interested in being a member of the Rebel Regiment marching band. Participation in this course will require some after school practices and performances. The Rebel Regiment has won eleven state championships and are the defending 2017 Upper State Champions. Percussion students must complete an audition in order to participate in this course.

Prerequisite	Band teacher recommendation		

This course is designed for students that are not in marching band that keep their skills up during first semester. This group will not have any required after school practices and only one required performance second nine weeks. Students will develop their performance abilities and practice all types of concert music.

PERCUSSION WHO PLAN TO BE IN MARCHING BAND

1ST SEMESTER: MARCHING BAND PERCUSSION 2, 3 or 4

2ND SEMESTER: SYMPHONIC BAND 2, 3 or 4 OR *SYMPHONIC BAND HONORS 2, 3 or 4

*You must audition for region band and score at least a 75 out of 200 to get honors credit

STUDENTS WHO DO NOT PLAN TO BE IN MARCHING BAND

1ST SEMESTER: FALL CONCERT BAND 2, 3 or 4

2ND SEMESTER: SYMPHONIC BAND 2, 3 or 4 or *SYMPHONIC BAND HONORS 2, 3 or 4

*You must audition for region band and score at least a 75 out of 200 to get honors credit

JAZZ BAND- Jazz band is optional and requires minimal time. You must be registered for a Symphonic band in order to take jazz band

SYMPHONIC BAND (AS A SECONDARY CLASS) – upperclassmen registered for Symphonic Band honors may also sign up for regular Symphonic Band also and learn a second instrument

NOTES

- You must be registered for marching band class in order to participate in the Rebel Regiment- Any extenuating circumstances would need band director approval
- Taking band both semesters makes you a much stronger individual performer. Students should take both semesters in order to be a band officer. Taking band both semesters is encouraged of all students.
