Minutes of General Membership Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Lindsay Rosillo @ 7:00 pm after determining that a quorum was present.

Absent with excuse were the following officers: Becky Gossett - Operations for Guard; Jenny Goings - VP Ways & Means; Meredith Gergley - VP Development; Shannon Wiley - Treasurer for Band and Will Archie - Director of Color Guard.

Annette Riley presented the minutes from the November 12th Booster Club meeting. A motion was made to accept the minutes from the November 12th meeting. Motion passed and meeting minutes from the November 12th meeting were approved.

Lindsay Rosillo gave the Ways and Means report in the absence of Jenny Goings. The mattress fundraiser is Feb.8th from 10am-5pm at the school. We have yard signs available to take home. Jan. 28th from 4pm-8pm is a spirit night at Panera Bread. In the past you needed a flyer for the band to receive credit, this no longer applies. Just let the cashier know you are there for the Rebel Regiment spirit night. There will be a guard fundraiser at Eggs Up Grill tomorrow (Jan.8th) from 5pm-7pm. Tickets are \$10 and can be purchased at the door.

Shelley Wildenstein gave the Communications Report. Please let her know if any updates that need to be done to the website.

Shelley also gave the Guard report in the absence of Becky Gossett. CWEA (the guards biggest fundraiser) volunteers are needed, sign ups for volunteers will be posted. CWEA will be held March 7th. January 8th at 8pm Winter Guard will have a preview show. Admission will be \$5 and a basket raffle will be held. Other local schools (Dorman and Powdersville to name a few) will be joining in the show this year.

Robert More gave the transportation report. The trailer used the last few years is in ill repair and needs to be replaced. Underneath the trailer has a significant amount of rust and is unsafe for road travel. The current trailer can be used as storage if new trailers are purchased.

Kate Johnson gave the Treasurer's Report in the absence of Shannon Wiley. Kate stated that the band's savings in good shape should an unexpected cost hit the band.
