## UNIFORM RUN FOR COMPETITION BAND THIS THURS

Competition Band will do a uniform run through this Thursday at the end of practice. Here are some reminders of what to bring/have. We will give out shoes (to those who ordered) and gloves this week. Anyone who owes \$ for shoes needs to pay for those before we can give them out.

### HORNLINE AND PERCUSSION:

Black Band shoes- bring your shoes from home – ordered shoes will be given out during class  
 Black socks (NOT ankle socks) bring your own  
 Black bibber pants (provided)  
 Costume Top (provided)  
 Black show shirt - wear under costume top- bring from home  
 Red Gloves (Provided) No gloves needed for percussion  
 Black gangster Hat (provided)  
 Hair- students have been given details on what to do for hair- student leaders have made tutorials and posted them as well

Wear compression or gym shorts under your uniform pants- PLEASE don't wear jeans, sweatpants, - or anything bulky.

PLEASE DO NOT TAKE PICTURES OF THE UNIFORM RUN THRU THURSDAY This is not designed to be a photo-opp. This is for us to fix or address any uniform issues and give the students a chance to get used to being in their uniform. There will be plenty of opportunity to take pictures at the performance this Saturday
